SUBJECT: ADDITIONAL INFORMATION FOR THE LOCAL OPEN TENDER TITLED "WATER MANAGEMENT WORKS OF THE BAJA-BEZDAN CANAL"

Dear Tenderers,

In response to a request from a prospective tenderer, the Első Magyar Közbeszerzési Tanácsadó Zrt. on behalf of Lower Danube Valley Water Directorate (ADUVIZIG) provides the following additional information:

1. Question:

The works contract notice 16. 2. (a) (2) is required to demonstrate suitability at least one employee who shall act as site manager during the completion of the contract and has at least 12 months professional experience in the site management of non-water-utility related water engineering works (construction or reconstruction) and has the qualifications and experience necessary to obtain the licence marked "MV-VZ" according to the Government decree 266/2013 (VII.11.) or already having that (or equivalent) licence. The completion of the contract shall only be commenced when the site manager has obtained that licence and is listed in the register of the Hungarian Chamber of Engineers as so;

Question: Does the Tenderer understand it right that in the case of the site manager the licence marked "MV-VZ-R" according to the Government decree 266/2013 (VII.11.) (Subspecialty of Water Management Structures) is also an appropriate licence?

1. Answer:

Taking into consideration the volume and the complexity of the works, as well as the structures that have to be designed and build - driftwood removal platforms and boat ramps - , the complementary setting-out and geodesy tasks necessary for the proper accomplishment of the dredging works, the Contracting Authority is not in the position to accept MV-VZ-R licence (or the equivalent qualifications and experience) instead of the required MV-VZ licence (or the equivalent qualifications and experience).
